

Chamberlain Scholarship Application to the 2021 International Fundraising Conference Minneapolis, MN | June 28 - 30, 2021

Criteria: To be considered for a scholarship, the applicant must be employed by and have significant fundraising responsibility for a non-profit 501© (3) organization located in the Greater Philadelphia Region. <u>This scholarship is available only to first time attendees of the AFP International Fundraising Conference.</u>

- Candidate is employed as a fundraising professional or, if candidate is an executive director, a substantial amount of time must be devoted to fundraising.
- Candidate has never attended an AFP or NSFRE International Conference on Fundraising as a registered participant.
- Candidate must agree to complete an online evaluation form about his or her experience at International Conference.
- Only one individual from any local organization or institution may be selected.

Amount of Scholarship: The Chamberlain Scholarship will cover the registration fee. If selected, you will receive a special registration codes and an email from AFP to complete your registration. You or your employer will pay a \$10 processing fee as well as all travel and lodging expenses.

Cover Letter: With your application form, enclose a brief cover letter noting the following:

- 1) How will you and/or your organization benefit by your participation at the International Conference?
- 2) Why is financial scholarship assistance needed at this time?

Deadline: All application and cover letters are due by *Friday, February 19, 2021.* Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.
